**Goal 2:** By June 2013, the students of Broadneck High school will demonstrate a higher level of interest and engagement in learning as demonstrated by:

**Objective #1:** In 2005-06 the number of Broadneck High School students referred to the office 10 or more times for disciplinary action will be reduced by 1.4%.

Milestone(s): We will analyze disciplinary data using SASI Class XP to ensure that targeted sub groups are appropriately monitored

Evaluation: Did Broadneck High School reduce the number of students referred for disciplinary ten or more times action by 1.4%?

Strategy: Identify, design, and implement appropriate programs, with emphasis given to available technology, which will support an increased motivation to learn as evidenced by a decrease in disciplinary referrals.
