The pledge is free, and there is also no obligation to join the PTSO in order to participate in the pledge. As a concerned parent, I agree to join the SAFE HOMES PROGRAM by promoting a "no tolerance" message regarding alcohol use by minors in my presence and will abide by the following guidelines:

- I will refuse to allow parties or gatherings in my home where alcohol use may occur when I am not present.
- I will refuse to serve and will not allow minors to consume alcohol in my home or on my property.
- I will refuse to allow the use of illegal drugs in my home or on my property.
- I will feel comfortable calling host parents when my child is invited to a party at their home and will welcome verifications of party conditions at my home.
- I will permit the use of my name and phone number in the Principal's Newsletter as a member of the Safe Homes Program. By doing this I will join a support network or other concerned parents in discouraging underage alcohol and other drug use.
